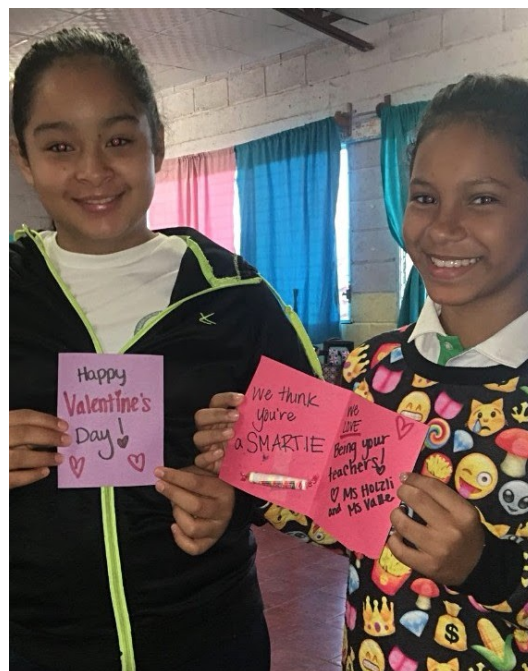
### How is love best expressed?
